Due to recent expansion, the company needed to further enhance its lighting with a focus on ensuring maximum efficiency across the site.

**LED technology** was selected for the project as the most cost effective and maintenance friendly option.

The work consisted of upgrading the 6m high bay lighting in each of the warehouses, replacing low bay fittings and installing emergency lighting into the low bays.

Externally, a number of new lampposts were added as part of the overall upgrade package to enhance safety across the site by providing extra lighting in previously unlit areas.



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
